What is SUMMIT?

SUMMIT is a week-long experience conducted by the Trapper Trails Council to give young men (ages 12-16) a meaningful experience in scouting that will enhance their knowledge and create a deeper understanding of their roles and responsibilities as leaders in their home troop. It is based on the BSA National Youth Leadership Training (SUMMIT - NYLT) Program. SUMMIT - NYLT replaces the course curriculum previously known as Junior Leader Training (JLT). The course focuses on teaching advanced leadership skills in a team-building atmosphere based on the patrol method. Participants will be regularly challenged to accomplish activities and projects using the leadership skills taught in the course. Participants will also have opportunities to improve their outdoor skills and apply them. The experience and fellowship received by being with a patrol of other boy leaders from other troops and **led by a quality, highly-trained, hand-picked youth staff** is significant for the participants. Our objective is for the participants to return to their troops with enthusiasm and ideas that will help make their job a lot easier and improve the troop's program.

Who should attend SUMMIT? (*Minimum Qualifications for SUMMIT - NYLT*)

- Enjoy Scouting.
- Be at least 12 years old on or before the beginning of the course.
- Have at least reached the rank of **FIRST CLASS SCOUT** on or before the beginning of the course.
- Have attended at least one long-term Scout Camp of five or more consecutive days with your troop before the beginning of the course.
- Display leadership potential and be likely to assume a leadership position during the coming year. (Senior Patrol Leader, Team Captain, etc.)
- Get your Parent's and Unit Leader's approval.

SUMMIT will nourish the leadership ability of the Scouts that are counted on to run a troop. SUMMIT will not help Scouts lacking in Scout spirit or Scouts who are generally not leaders counted on by their troop. The minimum qualifications and maturity level of the participants are counted on by the staff in order to run a successful program. If you have any questions about the appropriateness of any Scout attending SUMMIT, please do not hesitate to contact the Course Scoutmaster or Council Representative.

This is a great opportunity for the troops of our council. This program will make a positive difference in the lives of the Scouts who participate.
